

SHPO RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP

Enhance your research with perspective on the past

OVERVIEW

The Montana State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO), in partnership with the University of Montana (UM) and Montana State University (MSU), is offering a RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP to enrolled graduate students.

The Fellow will receive \$3,000 and waived tuition for up to three credits for effectively incorporating SHPO's online cultural records and GIS files into their research and contributing the resultant scholarly research paper or comparable product to Montana's Cultural Resource Database. A mentoring faculty member can earn an additional \$1,000 for pursuing publication.

The Database holds over 100,000 records including cultural resource inventory reports, records for archaeological sites and historic architecture, published works and gray literature specific to Montana resources, and more. Information within the database can provide long-lens perspective to investigations into social science and anthropology, Native American studies, humanities, history, land resources and environmental science, architecture, remote sensing, data science, and many additional topics.

- Completes application packet correctly and on time.
- Confirmed support from supervising faculty Mentor.
